Communication is very important to us. Our main way of communication is through email and Monthly Notes. Notes are distributed 3 ways;

- Emailed to active email addresses on
- Sent home with dancers
- posted in the lobby. If you've read the note and still have questions, PLEASE call or email. If you don't get an email with the note before the 3rd of every month, Please contact the office to update your email.

Performance Fees for ALL Dance, Cheerleading & Hip Hop classes (except tryout prep classes). This is divided into three payments of \$50 due Sept 1, Octl, Novl. The performance package includes the students costume for the recital, hairpiece & tights (if needed) 4 tickets to the recital. Each Student also receives a Beautiful Class Picture 8x10 collage, a professional digital download video of the recital and a very nice trophy. All performance packages cannot be cancelled and are non-refundable after Nov 15, 2020 *see back for payment examples (comp teams have a different schedule)

Dance CLOTHING is required, just like any other sport, shoes are very important and are required every-week. Girls in classes 6 yrs and under will wear a leather split sole ballet shoe. Girls 7 and older in Jazz/Ballet will wear Carmel Gore boots, Girls in Hip Hop will wear black Gore Boots. We stock a full selection of shoes that are more comfortable than large stores carry and the same price or better! Our ballets don't have laces! **WE DON'T**

ALLOWTHE CLOTH BALLET **SLIPPER.** These are not dance shoes, they are slippers designed to wear at home. Boy's Hip Hop and Cheerleaders should wear tennis shoes with nonmarking soles. **Dancers or cheerleaders** that don't have shoes will Not allowed to participate! Sorry due to COVID we cannot loan shoes.

Payments are due the first week of every month. Starting October 1, all accounts will be moved to Auto-Payment. All accounts must have a credit card on file, if you wish to pay other than a credit card, you must pay PRIOR to the 1st of the month. Make sure you keep your account up to date, failed transactions are billed extra after the 5th. Late fees will also apply.

As part of the Costume/Recital fee Every student will receive 4 tickets to their recital. Additional tickets will be \$6 in advance \$7 after May 1st and \$8 the week of the recital. To ensure a proper recital experience, we will only sell a limited number of tickets based on the available seats. Recital Tickets will go on sale Feb 2021. Sorry, we cannot replace lost tickets...

Online accounts: Everyone that has provided us with their email address has a free online account that can be accessed anytime. Click on "Account Login" on our website and follow the instructions.

Dancers should wear form fitting clothing, younger dancers Leo's with skirts. Older dancers like capri's with form fitting shirts. ALL GIRLS NEED TO PULL THEIR HAIR BACK FROM THEIR FACE! This is fundamental in all dance classes. No bare bellies are allowed during classes

Cheerleaders can wear any active wear and tennis shoes

Tumblers can wear any dance or active wear. They will go barefooted. We suggest a fitted type shirt in this class.

Tumbling will have a Tumbling Review May 26 at Roy High. The performance package for tumbling is two payments of \$40 due Nov 1st and Jan 1st-This includes an outfit for our tumblers, shirt and shorts, attendance for your entire family, & class photos. This gives our tumblers a performance opportunity that is essential to their progress

Music CD- A CD of your dancers music will be available for them to practice at home. The CD's will be available late fall. They are \$7. Emails will be sent out when they are available

- Please help us and your teachers by being on time dropping off and picking up for class.
- Please do not bring unregistered students to class.
- Please don't leave children under 18 in the lobby unattended (including friends)

COVID CHANGES
